The Board of Management of the Design Society is asking for proposals to host the 2019 (22nd) International Conference on Engineering Design. The bi-annual, four-day long conference is the "flagship" event of the Design Society, usually held around the second half of August. The organisation of the conference is executed in partnership with the Design Society, following a well-established task-sharing scheme.

Proposals are welcome before the end of December 2015. A final decision and details to be established before summer 2016.

Interested members of the Design Society are asked to contact the President for more details president@designsociety.org

At the very least, the proposal should address the following issues:

- Time, location
- Plenary meeting room(s): size(s), location(s), etc.
- Parallel sessions: number, locations, sizes, etc.
- Equipment available
- Panels, posters, exhibition area and reception: location, size, ability to hold alongside podium sessions, adequate area for exhibitions (e.g. publishers and the DS), etc.
- Budgets: a breakdown of the budget (only a first draft) to include a demonstration of how the agreed payment to the DS will be met and to include assurances that conference has the financial backing of the organisation making the bid.
- Accommodation: range, types, locations
- Meeting rooms: sizes, types, locations
- Gala Dinner and other social events: venue, seating, size, etc.
- Travel infrastructure
- The potential for technical visits
- Organisation members and procedures: having sufficient experience, responsibility and organisational structure to ensure a successful conference and production of conference documentation
- Confirmation of compliance with DS/Organiser Agreement and willingness to work with and communicate well with the DS/BM. Acceptance of an established structure and being willing to suggest developments and enhancements to the programme is important
